

Pearl Expert Titan Recovery CD Installation

Next the TITAN software will be installed. Before doing this you should make a backup to a USB pen any shows you have stored on the console since these will be erased. During this install process the console will re boot a number of times. You only need to press keys during the first boot and when prompted to enter serial numbers.

Insert the Titan CD and Power cycle the console using the front switch while observing the External VGA screen:

You will be prompted after a few moments with '**Boot from CD ...**

And then "**Press any key to boot from CD...**"

▶ Press a key on the QWERTY keyboard

You only have a few seconds to press a key (on the keyboard) to start the installation process from CD. If you miss this, the console will try to boot up as normal and so you will need to reboot and try again!

After the above key stroke the screen turns blue and in a black window a new prompt will appear:

'Avolites Titan Pearl Expert Installation and Recovery' press any key to continue...

▶ Press any key to continue

The Avolites software agreement will be printed to the screen, please read this carefully and type 'a' to confirm that you have read and agree to the license. Any other key will indicate you do not agree to the license and the installation process will be terminated

▶ Press "a" key to agree with the license and to continue the installation

After the above keystroke a new prompt will appear:

'Do you wish to partition the hard drive (Y/N)?'

▶ Type y and enter.

After the above keystroke a new prompt will appear:

'Warning all data on non-removable disk drive C: will be lost! Proceed with format (Y/N)?'

▶ Type y and enter.

After the above keystroke a new prompt will appear:

'Do you wish to install windows XP and the Titan operating system (Y/N)?'

▶ Type y and enter

The installer files are now copied onto the hard disk

After about 5 minutes the console will reboot, this time **do not** press any keys to Boot from CD.

Next the "First Boot Agent" will run and a bar will show the progress of this process. During the first boot period the panels and LCD screen on the console will flash several times, this is normal. At the end of the first boot period the console will reboot. (Again do not press any keys so that it won't boot from CD).

After this reboot further installation happens automatically and eventually you will then be prompted to enter the console serial number which can be found on the back of the console.

▶ You must enter a total of 5 characters, so the indicated serial number 765 is to be entered as 00785, enter to continue

The console will reboot (not pressing any keys again).

When the console has started up you are presented with a prompt to enter the "Product Activation Code", this is a six character code that is supplied on the black label you earlier fixed to keyboard.

▶ Enter the activation code, and "Enter" again when asked to restart Titan.

If the Activation Code is declined please refer to Annex B of the Titan Upgrade and Installation manual.

▶ Once Titan has restarted, remove the Installation CD from the CD drive.

▶ Press the power button on the front of the console to shutdown the console. This power cycle is important for the proper installation.

Wait for the console to shutdown then close the QWERTY Keyboard drawer and open the console. Place the recovery CD case which is above the keyboard drawer. Don't skip doing this, you may need this CD in the future and if it isn't in the console you will need to request a new one from Avolites.

Close the console and carefully fasten the four ¼ turn fasteners.

▶ Now press the power button again to start up the console.
